Made in Australia using Corian®, Dune has a polished finish creating reflection and enhancement of the form. Dune is available with a left or right hand bowl and provides a unique point of difference with uncompromising quality ideal for both residential and commercial environments.

"Dune challenges the perception of what a functional basin can be, enhancing user experiences rather than confronting and changing them. The fluid form is dynamic, current and adaptable to various environments, both commercial and residential. My aim is to design beautiful, sensitive products that consider progress and manufacturing possibilities. **Dune basin materials:** Corian® Glacier white and Night Sky. Corian® is an extremely durable acrylic based solid surface which can even be repaired if damaged, making it ideal for both commercial and residential areas.

**Manufacture:** The Dune wall basin is made in Australia.

**Designer:** In Thomas Coward's role as Principal Designer for Omvivo, he is responsible for the creation of new product to add to Omvivo's unique collection. His work is informed by the premise that design is not purely about solving physical problems. It is about exploring ongoing relationships between products and people and eliciting an emotional response. This assists him to create unique outcomes with often hidden qualities that reveal themselves over time. Coward moved to Australia in 2004 after studying and working in the UK. In 2005 Coward was recognised as one of Australia's top 50 emerging designers, and his *Parli-me* chair selected as one of only 16 exhibitors the City of Milan's young foreign designers showcase. More recently, Coward's 'Dune' basin won the idea 08 Product Fixtures and Fittings award in Australia, the Paris based Design and Design – 'Product design of the day' award and will be published in the Design and Design year book.
